### 📍 Binh Tay Market

One of Sai Gon's largest wholesale markets, buzzing with goods and the energy of local life.

18th-century temple to the sea goddess Mazu, famed for porcelain figurines and ornate roof.

### 📍 Cha Tam Church

A Catholic church with Chinese architectural touches, reflecting the diversity of Cho Lon.

### 📍 Nghia An Hoi Quan Pagoda

Atmospheric assembly hall dedicated to Quan Cong, the revered Chinese general.

### 📍 Traditional Medicine Street

Hai Thuong Lan Ong Street lined with herbal shops and centuries-old remedies.

### 📍 Flea Market

A lively market of second-hand goods and curios—perfect for local finds.

### 📍 Local Snack Stop

Taste a Chinese-Vietnamese snack or enjoy a refreshing iced tea.
